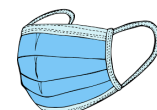
WHAT A YEAR FOR QUICKIE QUILTERS!

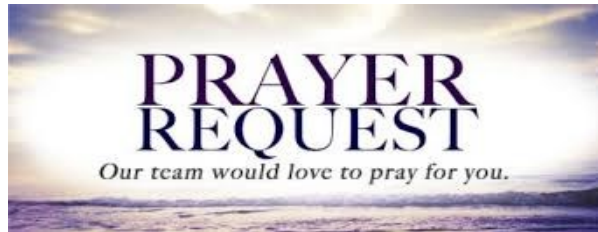
