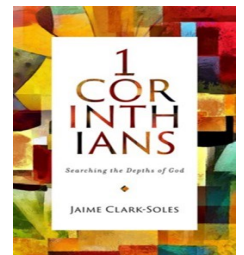
Graduation Celebration: If you have a graduate in your family you want to recognize, please send us the following information.
